

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-1**

The following Resolution was introduced by Mayor Olson, read in full, considered and adopted:

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-1 OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO** supports the proposed Enhancement project requesting FY 2003 Transportation Enhancement Funding for a new wayside interpretive site, new sidewalk and historic lighting, in the amount of \$174,760, and that it has the legal authority to apply for and pledge local matching funds recognizing that the request for a transportation enhancement project is not a grant application, that it is a request for reimbursement through the federal aid system, and that all federal rules for contracting, auditing and payment will apply; AND


Be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peck, Idaho.

Sec. 1 That the City of Peck shall provide matching funds for the proposed project in the amount of \$7000 (\$4000 cash and \$3000 donated). And

Sec. 2 that the City of Peck will provide maintenance for the project upon completion.

Sec. 3 That the Mayor of the City of Peck is hereby authorized and directed to sign the sponsor certification on the FY 2003 Application for Transportation Enhancement funds; and
