RESOLUTION NO. 2007-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PECK, NEZ PERCE COUNTY, IDAHO TO
AMEND AND CORRECT THE ANNEXATION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY
LIMITS OF PECK INTO THE BIG CANYON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Peck passed an ordinance authorizing the annexation of the area included within the city limits of Peck into the Big Canyon Fire Protection District;

WHEREAS, after passage it appeared that it was necessary to make additions and corrections to said ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council for the City of Peck, Nez Perce County, Idaho as follows:

Section 1: The area annexed into the Big Canyon Fire district is referred to by a map attached to the original ordinance as Exhibit "A". The map attached to the ordinance shall also include the legal description of the city limits of Peck attached to this resolution as Exhibit "B" and be included in the ordinance as though fully set forth as Exhibit "B" thereto.

Section 2: The statutory authority listed under Section 3.0 of the annexation ordinance contains a scrivener's error and shall be corrected to read Idaho Code §31-1423 rather than 31-1429.

Section 3: Further the annexation ordinance rescinds the contract between the City of Peck and the Big Canyon Fire Protection District which now provides for fire protection services and payment therefore rendered to the City of Peck. The Council has been advised that the annexation will not be effective until January 1, 2008. Therefore, the rescission of the contract now existing between the City of Peck and the Big Fire Protection District is withdrawn. The contract providing for fire protection services between the Big Canyon Fire District and the City of Peck and payment therefore shall continue in full force and effect until such time as the annexation process of the city limits into the Big Canyon Fire Protection District is complete and effective. The contract shall then be rescinded without further action by either party.

Section 4: This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval

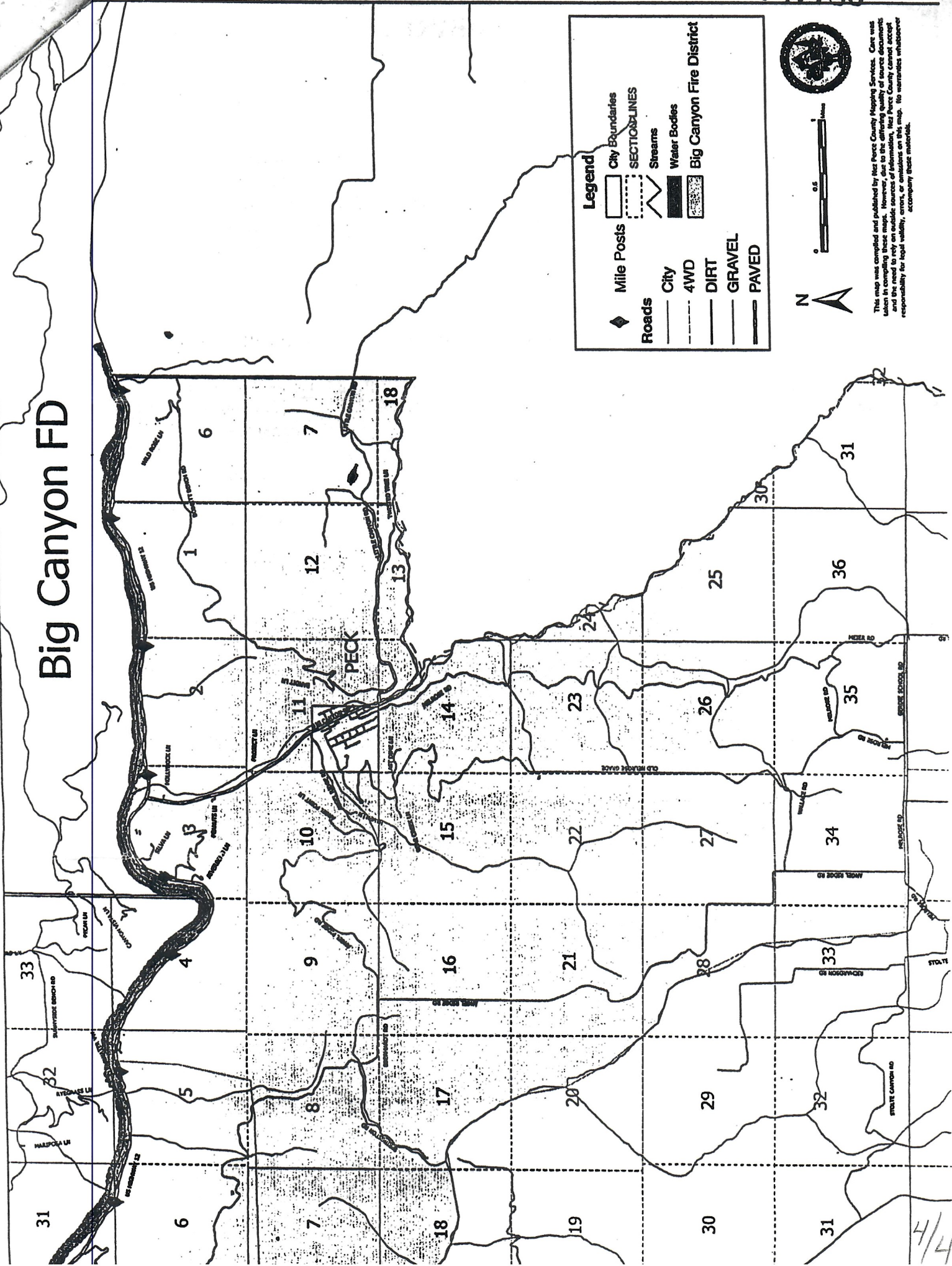
